1. First	Hanford, CA	Additional funds to the original grant—the Board agreed to fund 2/3 of the actual financial cost to this project, to provide assistive listening devices.
2. Peace	Sacramento, CA	Hosting “Disability Awareness Workshop,” for reaching families impacted by disabilities.
3. St. Paul's	Tracy, CA	Free Vacation Bible School for the children of the community.
4. First	Lucerne, CA	Additional funds for Food and Necessity Cupboard—outreach to community
5. Resurrection	Santa Clara, CA	Hosting a “Fall Kick-Off Block Party” on 9/10/17 to reconnect with those in the church’s immediate area
6. Redeemer	Fresno, CA	Hosting a Women’s Retreat, Sept. 8 – 9, to include 6 churches in surrounding area
7. Trinity	Wahiawa, HI	For Every Door Direct Mailing to advertise the Wahiawa Kaiaulu Student Grant to one family for the upcoming school year.
8. Trinity	Watsonville, CA	Hosting a festival for preschool families, church families, and the community (churched and un-churched)
9. Trinity	Stockton, CA	Community Christmas Party and Luncheon for needy families in the community.
10. Zion	North Highlands, CA	Neighborhood-wide day of activities to reach their diverse and economically challenged neighborhood.
11. St. Mark	Santa Rosa, CA	Funds to be applied to the work of a disaster fire coordinator and if not needed should Synod release funds for this position, may also be used for relief for fire victims.
12. Trinity	San Rafael, CA	To provide assistance for Trinity's "TNT Club," an after-school program for middle school (grades 6-8) students.
13. Faith	Pleasant Hill, CA	A workshop to reach out to clergy, Christians, and non-Christians to make them more aware of those who are disabled and how their needs are being met, particularly spiritual needs.
